

All Region Clinic 2024

November 2nd

Dear Parent/Guardian,

This Saturday we will be having our All Region Clinic at **Russellville High School Performing Arts Center**. We are asking that all students that made the All Region choirs meet at Ramsey in the courtyard that morning at **6:15 am**. We will then depart from Ramsey to Russellville at **6:30 am**.

The All Region clinic is comprised of students from other schools in our region who also auditioned and made the All Region choirs. Students will meet in a designated rehearsal room to work through the music with the other students. The “end product” will be a concert that evening, open to the public. The concert times are: **Vox Anima** (Tenor-Bass choir) 4:00pm , **Bella Voce** (Treble-Odds) 4:30pm , and **Cantabile** (Treble-Evens) 5:00pm. **NOTE* These were times for last years concerts. These times may change as information is received.*

Students are **required** to bring their: **choir folder, pencil, money for food (\$10-\$20), and choir uniform (wear black underneath the robes and black shoes)**. There will also be All Region choir t-shirts that can be purchased in the lobby before and during the choir concert. **NOTE* The All Region shirts are not handled by Ramsey choir. The shirts will be delivered to Ramsey and given to students that ordered them.*

After the concert, parents are more than welcome to take their child home if they wish. We simply ask that you **meet Mr. Lee or Ms. Sattazahn in the lobby of the auditorium to check out**. We are responsible for every student that goes with us that day. If they are taken home without checking out we will try calling the student and parent. If we cannot reach either party, we will be forced to call the local authorities. (We would like to avoid that.) If your student rides the bus back with us, we will be arriving back at Ramsey around 7pm. We ask that parents/guardians be at Ramsey to pick up students by 7pm. **NOTE* The arrival time to Ramsey is TENTATIVE. Please make plans to pick up students.*
